Definition of Copyright

An exclusive right given by the law for a determinable time period to the author to make copies of their work.





Requirements

- Work is categorized by the Copyright Act 1987
- 2. Work must be reduced to material form
- 3. Work must be original
- 4. Work must be qualified for protection





Manner of Protection

 Automatic protection upon creation of work

Voluntary notification of copyright with the MyIPO





Duration of Copyright

Literary, Musical / Artistic Works

- Life of author plus 50 years after death of author

Published editions, sound recordings, broadcasts, films and works of government, government organisation & international bodies

- 50 years from the beginning of the calendar year next following year when it is published





Rights Granted

- Economic Rights
- Moral Rights
